


Interviewing Children: A skills-based course for a range of professionals

COURSE OVERVIEW

This self-paced course is the culmination of over 10 years research and development by the Centre for Investigative Interviewing. The Centre is a global leader in the field of interviewing children (www.investigativecentre.com).

The course takes 20-30 hours and focuses on the 'how to' of interviewing children for workplace investigation purposes. It is practical and interactive in nature, including a child avatar, professional films with quizzes, and one-on-one sessions (over the phone or web) with a tutor. Where appropriate, activities are tailored to suit individual enrollees' work contexts. A certificate is provided on completion.



LEARNING OUTCOMES

The course focuses on the questioning strategies needed to: build rapport, encourage disclosures, keep the child talking (and steer them to important details), and minimise error while making the interview as stress-free as possible.

EVIDENCE BASE FOR COURSE EFFECTIVENESS

Evaluation research using control groups and standardised assessment measures reveals that participants who complete this course are highly skilled in using a range of good questions, their interviews are shorter without loss of important information, and their skills are maintained well over time.

ENROLMENT

The cost for individuals is \$950 AUD (plus 10% GST within Australia). This covers full access to the online learning environment and a trainer.
